General Instructions

- Candidates appearing for interview at ISI Kolkata must report at the Seminar Room, Economic Research Unit, 6th Floor, S N Bose Building, in the ISI Kolkata campus 15 minutes prior to the

designated time of interview.

Candidates appearing for interview at ISI Delhi must report at the Auditorium in the ISI Delhi campus 15 minutes prior to the designated time of interview.

- During the interview, the candidates must present the original of their valid photo-id proof (Aadhaar Card, Driving License, Voter Id, Passport, PAN, E-Aadhaar printout) which they mentioned during application. Candidates are also required to bring originals and one set of photocopies of their Academic records (e.g., marksheets and certificates of board examinations) and all supporting documents (e.g., Category certificate, PwBD certificate, GEN-EWS certificate, Domicile certificate etc.) submitted at the time of application.
- **Travel Support:** All outstation candidates belonging to GEN-EWS, SC/ST categories and/or having PwBD status will be provided travel support for attending interview through reimbursement of two-way sleeper/second class railway fare and/or bus fare between their home station and the place of interview by the shortest route, on submission of the original or photocopy (as applicable) of their railway and/or bus tickets.

Eligibility for travel support of candidates from economically backward classes will be determined by the possession of BPL card. For the other categories, eligibility will be subject to verification of the relevant certificates at the time of interview. For reimbursement of travel expenses, which will be made via bank transfer, the candidate must provide, at the time of interview, particulars of his/her bank account, including Account name and number, Bank name, branch, address and IFSC.

- A limited number of shared, on campus accommodation is available for outstation candidates appearing for interviews. It may be noted that the accommodation will be arranged for a maximum of two days and one night only.
